LOCATION: Barksdale CDC East (Bldg. 3725) & Barksdale Youth Center (Bldg. 3722) Childcare for Ages 6 weeks-5 years and for Ages 5 years (in kindergarten)-12 years

REGISTRATION REQUIRED

Register up to two weeks prior through COB on the Friday prior to the event. Registrations must be done in person at the CDC or Youth Center facility. Slots are first come, first served. Once the slots are filled, we will make a waiting list. **GPAB Referral Certificate and current immunization records are required.**

ELIGIBLE FOR GPAB REFERRALS

The Air Force member being deployed, on extended TDY, or remote tour of duty, a family crisis or emergency (i.e. serious illness of family member, death in the family, extended illness of family members, birth of a new baby, etc.), having a child with special needs, unique circumstances or hardships.

FAMILIES MUST BE REFERRED BY: Squadron Commander/First Sergeant, Chaplain, Doctor or other medical professional, Family Advocacy/ Mental Health Professional, Airman & Family Readiness Personnel

OTHER IMPORTANT INORMATION

Parents must sign children in/out of the centers. Parents must pick up their children by the designated closure time. A late fee of \$2 per minute is assessed for late pick up. Parents/Sponsors are responsible for all late fees. Snack will be provided. Lunch/Dinner will not be served. GPAB referral can only be used once per month.
