

EXPANDED CHILD CARE(ECC) OPPORTUNITIES

Barksdale AFB Family Child Care Program has several ECC programs available to qualified participants. These programs are designed to help assist families with special child care needs.

SUPPLEMENTAL CHILD CARE (SCC) Designed to augment a member's existing child care by providing free child care during official duty hours at the beginning/end of a 12+ consecutive hour shift that falls "outside of" the primary child care arrangement for children 2 weeks to 12 years of age.

DEPLOYMENT CARE Offers 16 hours per month per child of free child care for children ages 2 weeks to 12 years of Active Duty, National Guard & Reserve members assigned to an AF or Joint Base AF-led installation. Services used before, during and/or after member's assignment in support of contingency operations. "Remote Care now available."

EXTENDED DUTY CARE (EDC) Provides child care to parents who have unexpected shift changes, such as working late, working on weekends or other child care emergencies at no additional cost to the parent.

SUBSIDY CARE Provides child care fee assistance to parents that require full-time care children and are unable to utilize CDC or SAC due to full capacity. Some FCC providers also care for children with special needs, swing/midnight shift or non-normal working hours. Fees are based on Total Family Income, just like CDC or SAC.

HOME COMMUNITY CARE (HCC) Provides free care for Guard and Reserve members (all branches) for primary Unit Training Assembly weekends.

PCS CARE Allows 20 hours of free child care per child for parents of ALL branches of service that are arriving to or leaving, an AF base installation. "Provided by Air Force Aid Society. Eligible members will apply through the AFAS Member Portal at: <https://portal.afas.org> and receive funding directly into designated bank account via Zelle or ACH to pay for the allowable child care. DAF FCC can provide you with a list of licensed DAF FCC providers.

MILITARY SPOUSE APPOINTMENT CARE (MSAC) 16 hours of free child care per month per child. To be eligible: Spouse of AD Military or Reserve/Guard in activated status. Sponsor must be at work, on directed crew rest, or must attend the appointment. No other adult in the household is available to provide care for spouse to attend an approved appointment.

WOUNDED WARRIOR CARE Provides free child care for families of Wounded Warriors who have short-term care needs.

BEREAVEMENT CARE Offers free care for families who have an immediate family fallen military member.

EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE Provides child care for families experiencing medical issues with immediate family members.
